Development of Women Entrepreneur

HSBC Bangladesh has remained supportive to the development of women entrepreneurs in every possible ways. In 2016, the Bank had provided training to 90 women entrepreneurs in collaboration with SCITI (Small and Cottage Industries Training Institute). Groups of 30 women from Sylhet, Chattogram, and Mymensingh were given training on how to develop a business plan, manage finance, maintain accounts, market their products, etc.

In 2019, HSBC Bangladesh is going to provide skill development and entrepreneurship training to 400 rural women in association with NGO Young Power in Social Action (YPSA). After the training is completed, YPSA will provide financial support through YPSA's microfinance program (supported by PKSF) to eligible candidates so that they can get a startup funding to initiate their business.
